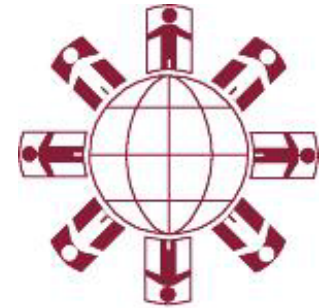

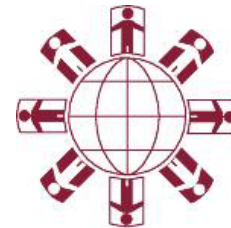

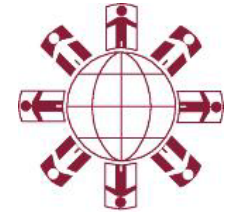
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Why the Next Generation?

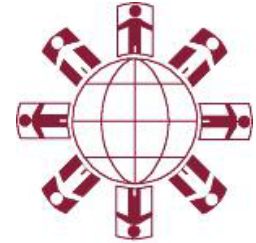
- The old ways of doing development have not really worked - we need a paradigm shift in development to being participative and inclusive at all levels
- Empowering the next generation opens the way for a generation that is well-equipped to deal with the complexities of the 21st century and beyond
- The next generation is more inclined to embrace innovation (e.g. the use of technology)

How to Engage the Next Generation

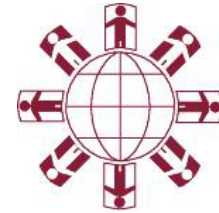


- New stakeholders, e.g. the youth who bear the brunt of social/economic/political problems, through developing truly youth driven initiatives, e.g. HOMEY, Ghana, Focus Clubs
- Volunteerism, philanthropy and civic engagement in developing countries
- Building the capacity of and working with grassroots organizations as major stakeholders
